






SEDONA VINEYARD TOURS




D.A. RANCH

Ranch, a boutique vineyard in a historic location —known for exceptional wine tasting experiences and special events. Located just minutes from Sedona and Old Town Cottonwood, the ranch is nestled in a valley between House Mountain and Oak Creek, with some of the best views in the Verde Valley. Fed by natural artesian springs and harvested to create the 100% estate–grown, limited production wines, the vineyard produces some of the most unique wines in the region.

As Northern Arizona's only 100% estate-grown vineyard, many varietals are vinified on the property, including Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Tannat and Seyval Blanc. Due to the unique micro climate and terrain, D.A Ranch wines are rich in minerals, highlighted by earth and fruit characteristics. Wine Tastings are available during select days from 11 a.m. – 6 p.m., and do not require reservations unless you are a group of 13 or more. The tasting room offers wines available for sale by the glass or as a tasting flight, and you can enjoy your wine experience in the tasting room, on the porch, or within the boundaries of any one of the expansive outdoor seating areas.





JAIL TRAIL FROM RIVERFRONT PARK OR OLD TOWN

Easily accessible from the old jail parking area on Main St. in Old Town Cottonwood, this easy 1.6-mile loop features massive Cottonwood trees and a family-friendly, dog-friendly trail that weaves through the Verde River Greenway State Natural Area.







CIBOLA PASS AND JORDAN TRAILS

Located in Uptown, The Cibola Pass Loop and Jordan Trail are some of our favorite hikes in Sedona. The Cibola Pass Loop (2 miles) is generally considered an easy route, and for the more adventurous, the Jordan Trail is a point to point trail that provides access to many miles of hiking trails in the Sacred Mountain Wilderness. Both trails allow you to experience some of the best vistas and red rock formations that the area has to offer. Cibola Pass and Jordan Trail are popular areas for hiking, trail running, and biking, so be prepared for other people to be around if you are visiting during peak time. The trail is open year-round, but the best times to visit are July through October. Dogs are welcome, but

must be on a leash.



CRESCENT MOON RANCH

The cemented walkway that weaves through the park makes Crescent Moon Ranch a favorite for those who desire accessibility along with incredible views of Cathedral Rock. Oak Creek winds through most of the park, which gives the area a peaceful energy while maintaining its natural beauty year round. There is also a large picnic area with shared and non shaded picnic tables and a wheelchair accessible restroom. From here, you can visit Red Rock Crossing Vortex, one of Arizona's most iconic sites.





SLIDE ROCK STATE PARK

Just seven miles north of Sedona, in an area called Oak Creek Canyon, **Slide Rock State Park** offers a fun-filled day for visitors of all ages. At Slide Rock, you can picnic, hike, or bike through the former apple orchard, made famous by Oak Creek's natural water slide. The "slide" in Slide Rock is an exhilarating 80-foot-long red-rock chute that has a seven percent decline from top to bottom. Algae on the rocks creates the slippery ride. While the slide is sure to bring thrills, you can also bring an inner tube to float downstream and take a dip in one of **America's top 10 most beautiful swimming holes.**



Wildlife such as deer, javelina, and coyote are native to the area and can often be seen throughout the year. In addition, the park is home to more than 140 bird species. Picnic areas, charcoal grills, and two large ramadas with electrical outlets are available for gatherings or events.

OLD TOWN COTTONWOOD

Old Town Cottonwood is a picturesque, year-round destination, where one can step back in time. Known as "The Heart of Verde Valley Wine Country", this quaint town is known for its historical architecture, some of which has been recognized by the National Registry of Historic Places. In Cottonwood you can enjoy wonderful gastropubs, restaurants, tasting rooms, breweries and distilleries, or browse the area's one-of-a-kind boutique shops.

DEAD HORSE RANCH STATE PARK

Located in the Coconino National Forest in Cottonwood, **Dead Horse Ranch State Park** has plenty of highlights that make this a favorite destination. Adjacent to the **Verde River Greenway State Natural Area**, an area dedicated to conserving land in its natural state, Dead Horse Ranch has a unique ecosystem, making it the perfect place to enjoy Arizona in its purest form. Keep an eye out for raptors, neotropical migrants, songbirds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and fish.


At an elevation of 3,300 feet, Dead Horse Ranch State Park offers mild temperatures that allow visitors to enjoy activities such as camping, biking, hiking, canoeing, and exploring. In addition, the nearby river and lagoons make the park an excellent site for beginning or seasoned anglers. The waters are stocked with Rainbow Trout throughout the winter and Channel Catfish in the warmer months, so casting a line any time of year is sure to get you a bite or two. Finally, don't let the name fool you! Dead Horse Ranch State Park is located in a beautiful area in Cottonwood, with no expired animals in sight.





JEROME

Nicknamed "The City in the Sky" or "The Wickedest Town in The West", Jerome, Arizona, was one of America's most famous and infamous mining camps. In its 70+ years as an active mining town, Jerome produced over a billion dollars worth of gold, copper, silver, and zinc, with the final mine closing in 1953. Today, Jerome is a unique and popular hillside destination for visitors eager to discover more about the Verde Valley's wines, fine art, mines, and paranormal activities. Many buildings from the late 1890s are still standing and occupied by vintage shops, restaurants, and antique stores. If spirits are what you seek, take one of Jerome's famous Ghost Tours, where you may catch a glimpse of some of Jerome's past residents, who are said to haunt the Jerome Hotel, the local hospital, and the old jailhouse.









COLT GRILL

Colt Grill is a first class barbecue grill in the charming District of "Old Town Cottonwood", featuring a menu made entirely from scratch! In this modern farm house atmosphere, you can enjoy baby back ribs, tender beef brisket, smoked turkey, pulled pork, ranch beans, handmade veggie burgers, crisp salads, hand pressed fries, and hand ground burgers. The seasonal menu changes daily, and you can enjoy some of the best BBQ in Arizona on the large covered patio, accompanied by a water fountain and bubble lights for outdoor dining under the stars.

PIZZERIA BOCCE

A taste of Italy in Arizona is hard to come by, unless, of course, you are dining at Pizzeria Bocce. This chic, modern outdoor eatery boasts authentically made pizza and pasta with world-class ingredients. Every pizza is handmade with Caputo flour imported from Italy, and baked in a wood-burning stove. FUN FACT: Crema Craft Kitchen is housed in two of Old Town's historic and notorious 1930's buildings, which were once owned and operated by a convicted bootlegger. During Prohibition, much of Old Town was connected by underground tunnels used for smuggling.
